Advanced English Technical Writing	The English composition and technical writing prerequisite course should provide an overview of persuasive writing and should further develop the technical writing skills of the student. The course should include critical thinking and creation of written documents in a business or technical format as desired.	3	ENGL 110
Psychology	The introductory psychology prerequisite course should provide an overview of basic course content should include fundamentals of human behavior.	3	PSYC 101
Abnormal Psychology	The abnormal psychology prerequisite course should provide an overview of abnormal behavior and mental health.	3	PSYC 201
Sociology	The introductory sociology prerequisite course should provide an overview of social units, culture, and sociological theory.	3	SOCY 101 or SOSC 201
Development Across the Life Span	The life span development prerequisite course should provide an overview of growth and development throughout the life span.	3	PSYC 303 or HLTH 303
Oral Communication or Public Speaking	The oral communication/public speaking prerequisite course should provide an overview of communication. The course should include preparation and presentation of speeches on an individual basis.	3	COMM 120

Anatomy and Physiology-I with Lab	Anatomy and physiology prerequisite course should include acquired information on the structure and function of the human body. Course content should be at a level	6 – 8 total credits	BIOL 221 and BIOL 221 L and BIOL 222 and BIOL 222 L
Anatomy and Physiology-II with Lab	I and II should have a laboratory component either as a separate course or embedded within the main lecture course.
